

Make and Do Suncatcher

INSTRUCTIONS



1



On the paper there are two pencil lines. Cut on the lines – if you are struggling ask an adult to help you.

2



You can keep the folded pieces together and cut both at once, but keep the folded edges the same side.

3



Next, open them up and you will have two hearts from the middle, and two hearts (pink) or two leaves (green) with space in the middle.

4



Carefully glue the edge of these two open hearts/leaves (on the pencil side) and place the film over one side covering the hole – ask if you need help from an adult.

5



Cut off the excess film that is outside the shape.

6



Fold the string you have in half and stick the two loose ends in the top dip of the heart or stalk of the leaf.

7



Put a dab of glue on top of the string or ribbon and place the glued side to the film side of the cut out.



8



Cut off the excess film that is outside the shape.

9



Hang in a window and as it turns the sun will make it sparkle.
