Abraham was to go on a long journey to a place called Canaan.

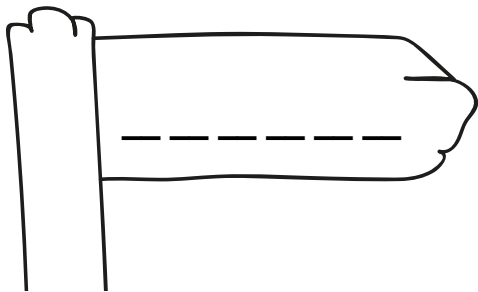
Abraham trusted God and set out. His wife Sarah and his nephew Lot went with him.

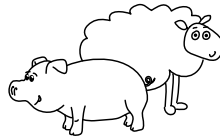

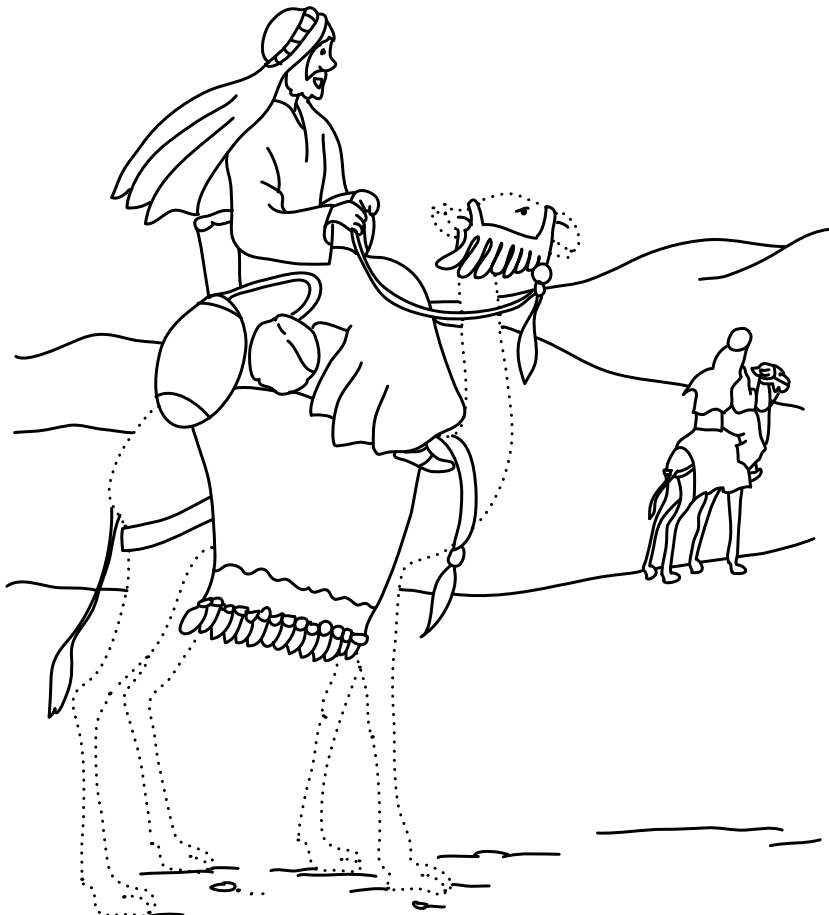

Note: Abram and Sarai's names change to Abraham and Sarah in Genesis 17.

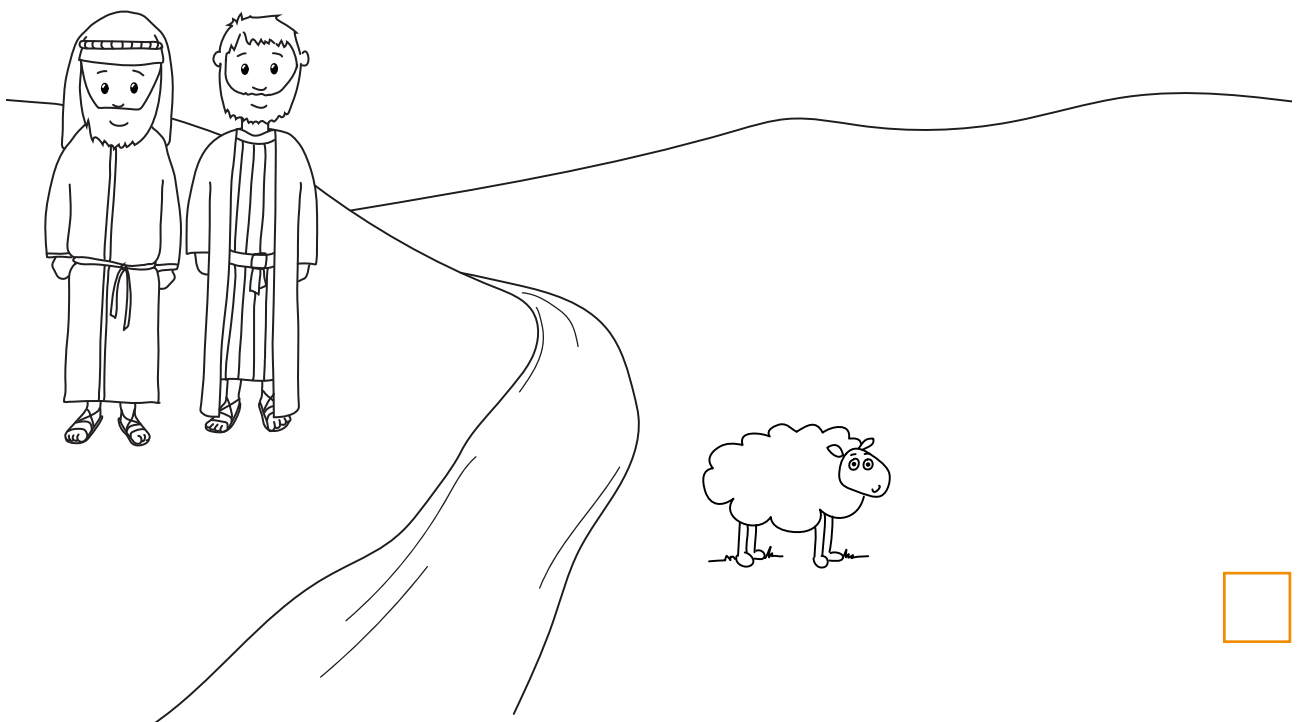


Abraham and Lot both had large flocks of sheep and many servants to look after them.

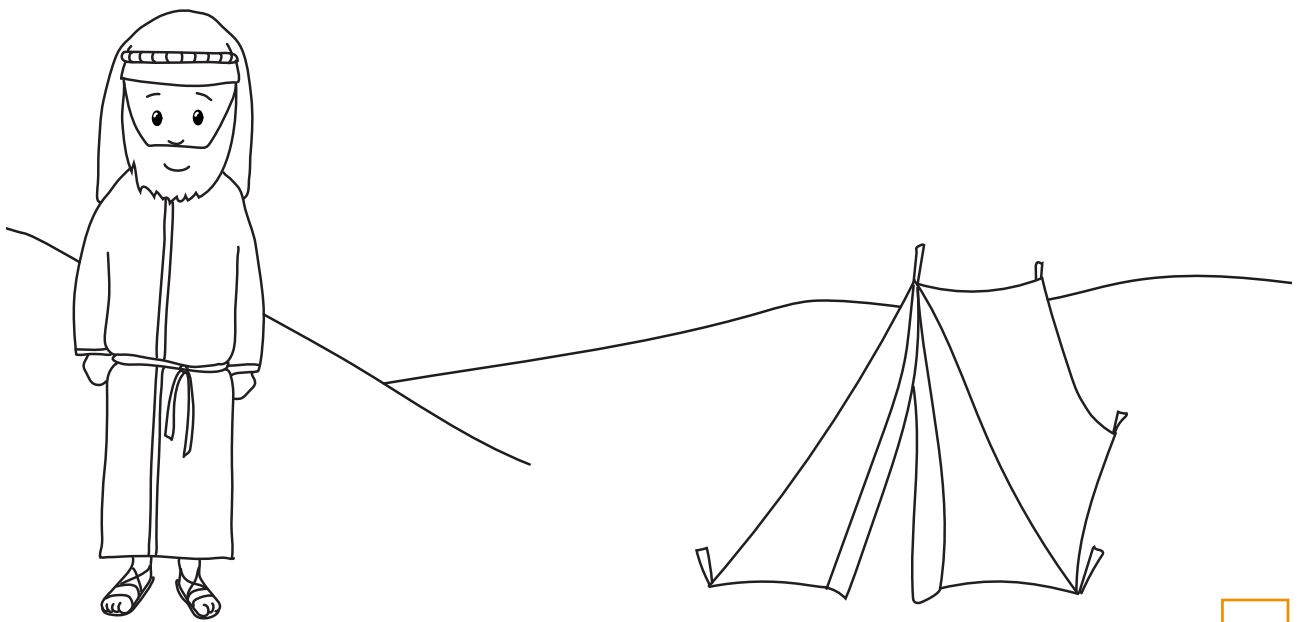

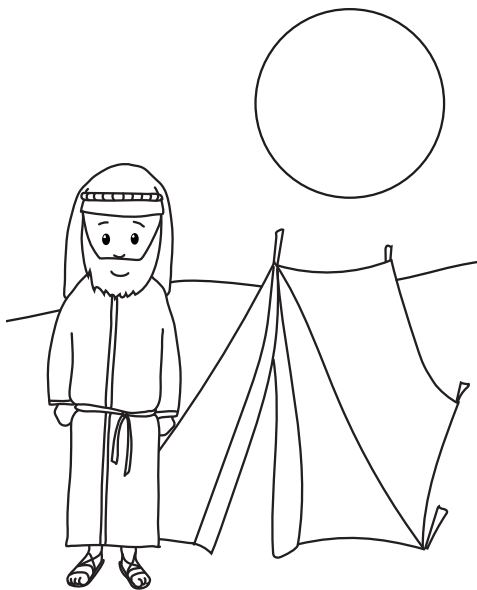
STORY 4: Abraham and the visitors

at the idea!

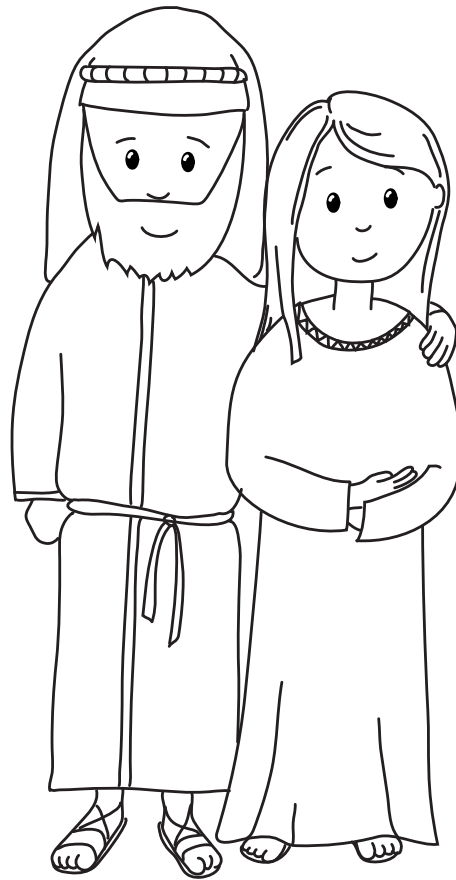
