





# **Paper Aeroplane Instructions**




STEP 1

Fold the paper in half along the long edge, and then open again so you have a crease mark down the middle.




STEP 4

Using the crease mark in the centre of paper, fold it in half so the triangle is now hidden.




**STEP 7** 

Repeat Step 2 and so you have a point at the front of the plane again.




STEP 2

Fold the top of each corner to the crease in the middle of the paper, so you end up with a point at the front of the plane.




STEP 5

Using the corner of the paper where the triangle meets, tear a square of the paper..




STEP 8

You should now have a small triangle in the square cut out.




#### STEP 3

Take the point at the front of the plane, and fold it down along the edge of the bottom of the triangle.



STEP 6

Open the paper out again, and now you will have a missing square both sides of the paper at the top.




#### STEP 9

Take the small triangle in the square cut out, and fold it forwards so it's pointing to the front of the plane.




### Paper Aeroplane Instructions continued...




#### **STEP 10**

Using the crease mark in the centre of paper, fold it in half so the small triangle is now on the outside of the plane.



#### **STEP 11**

From the front corner, fold the paper down roughly along the dotted line above to create the wing, and repeat on the other side.



#### **STEP 12**

Your wings should look like the picture above.

Now you aeroplane is finished and ready to fly!
